All the Principals of Government/Aided/Unaided Junior Colleges in the State are directed that a sum of Rs.5/- out of the amount collected towards games fund towards each student should be sent to the concerned District Vocational Education Officers of their concerned district in the prescribed proforma (copy enclosed) through Demand Drafts in the name of the concerned District Vocational Education Officers in the proportionate to the student strength.

Further the District Vocational Education Officers in the state are hereby directed to retain an amount of Rs.2/- (out of the Rs.5/-) towards the district share for conducting of district meet.

The remaining amount of Rs.3/- per student of each college should be submitted by the District Vocational Education Officer concerned to the Commissioner of Intermediate Education in one consolidated Demand Draft for the entire amount (Rs.3/- of State share). The Demand Draft should be made only in favour of "Commissioner of Intermediate Education, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad" alongwith a detailed statement college-wise as per the proforma enclosed.

The Regional Inspection Officers in the State are requested to make necessary arrangements for collection of Rs.5/- out of the amount collected towards games fund in respect of each student in unaided Private Junior College under their control and all the particulars along with Demand Drafts may be sent to District Vocational Education Officers of their concerned district. The District Vocational Education Officers are directed to retain an amount of Rs.2/- per student of the college towards the district share to meet the district tournaments and the amount of Rs.3/- per student of each college should be sent to the Commissioner of Intermediate Education, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad in one consolidated Demand Draft for the entire amount. The Demand Draft should be drawn only in favour of "Commissioner of Intermediate Education, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad".

Further the District Vocational Education Officers/Regional Inspection Officers are hereby instructed to furnish all these amounts in consolidated statement and consolidated Demand Draft and the same should be sent to this office on or before 15.9.2002.
