c) The Correspondent should provide the Committee with the Seniority list of candidates, their personal files consisting of confidential reports (atleast for the last ten years for Principal position an atleast 8 years for promotion of Post Graduation Lectures to Readers position and 5 years for other posts), files pertaining to changes if any, certificates of required qualifications and marks lists of each candidate, relevant latest rules governing the posts, estimates of vacancies and such other material as required by the Promotion Committee, Promotion Committee shall scrutinise the R.F., qualifications, seniority etc., and after assesting the suitability of candidates it shall approve the list of names in the order of seniority and merit to the amount of vacancies.

The qualifications and scales of pay shall be as prescribed by the Government from time to time.

Necessary orders in respect of oriental college will issued separately.



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5. The posts of physical Directors in Degree Colleges shall be filled by recruitment by transfer from the qualified eligible and suitable Assistant Physical Directors of Degree Colleges and then Physical Directors of Junior Colleges under the same management provided they possess the qualification prescribed by the U.G.C. and in the absence of such Physical Directors by direct recruitment.

6. 50% of posts of Assistant Physical Directors in Degree Colleges shall be filled by recruitment by transfer from among the qualified, eligible and suitable Physical Directors of Junior Colleges under the same management and in the absence of such Physical Directors by direct recruitment.

7. The posts of Librarians in Degree Colleges shall be filled by recruitment by transfer from among the qualified, eligible and then the Librarians of the Junior Colleges under the same management provided they possess the qualification prescribed by the U.G.C. and in the absence of such librarians by direct recruitment.

8. The posts of Readers shall be filled by recruitment by transfer from among the qualified, eligible and suitable lecturers in Post Graduate Courses with not less than 8 years of service under the same management and in the absence of such senior Lecturers by direct recruitment.

9. The posts of Principals of Junior Colleges shall be filled by recruitment by transfer from among qualified eligible and suitable Junior Lecturers under the same management and in the absence of such Junior Lecturers by direct recruitment.

10. Panel shall be prepared every year for each category of posts consisting of only such number of candidates as is approximately equal to the number of vacancies expected to arise in that year and a mark for appointment by transfer. The estimate shall cover a period of 12 months following 1st July of each year.

The Correspondent of every Private College should see that a list of qualified candidates is omitted in the list on the ground that he considers him unfit or not yet fit for such appointment. The correspondent should furnish a certificate to the effect that the names of all qualified candidates have been included in the list.

The Correspondent shall give a certificate to the effect that the seniority list of candidates has been circulated to all and that no representation is received from them against the seniority fixed by the management..

11. If representations are received, they shall be placed before the Promotion Committee at the time of selection for the perusal.
